



The project aims at improving environment, through the segregation and recycling of Municipal Waste.

In Vrindavan before SGP the Municipal Corporation and the NGOs were working on Municipal waste but with SGP came the concept of Solid Waste Management and community ownerships and participation.

The project aims

- Segregation of garbage at source
- Public Participation and Awareness
- Recycling, Reuse and provide opportunities, livelihoods and facilitate better institutionalization of Rag Pickers

Results of project VISHWAS

- Segregation started
- Distribution of dustbins facilitated collection of Municipal Waste,
- Setting of Vermi-Compost Units
- Setting up a Paper Recycling Unit.

Obstacles

- Poor upkeep of the drains, they are open and there is no sewer system,
- No ban on use of Plastic..main cause of sewer blocking
- Door to door collection is difficult because of the Jagirdari system. The local Safai Mitr does not allow others to collect from house to house,
- People do not want to pay as they are paying taxes to the Municipal Board
